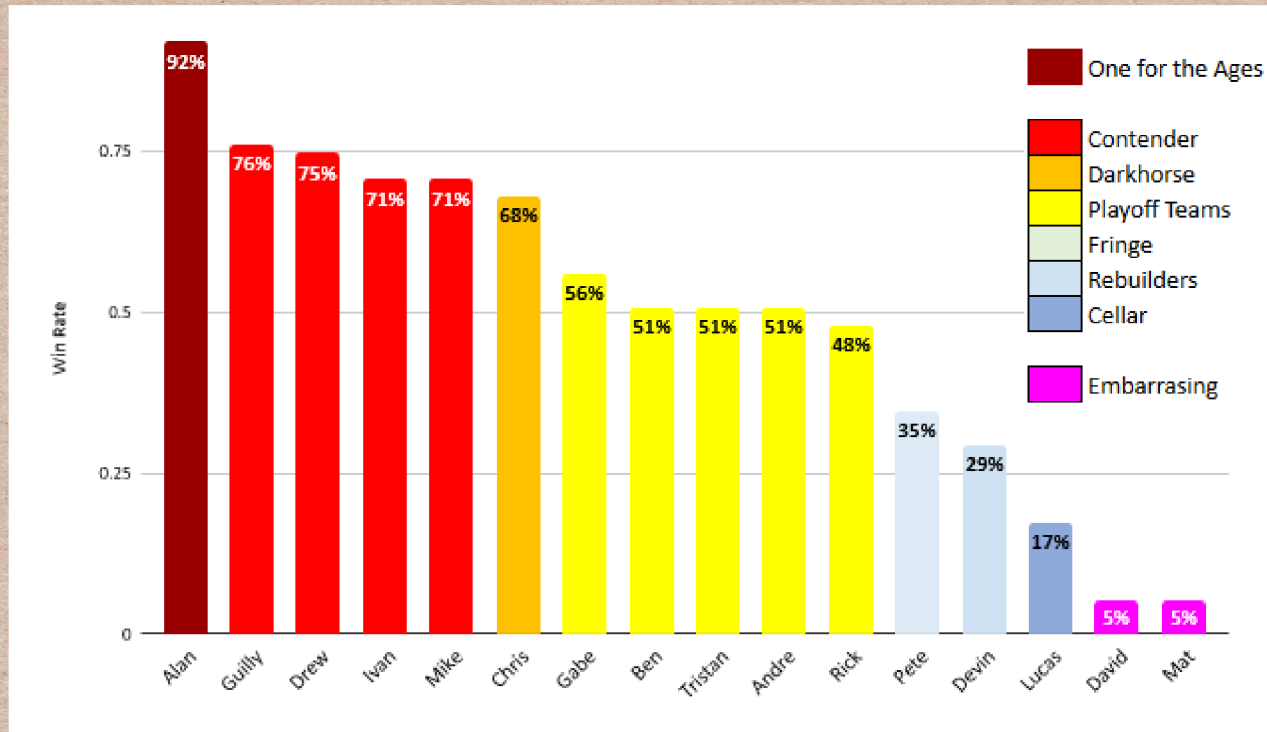

# LUCK OF THE SCHEDULE

Let's chat about luck for bit. I won't be featuring these charts every week but occasionally it can provide interesting insights (see below). Do you notice the pattern?

## WIN RATE BY DIVISION

North: 69%

South: 66%

East: 50%

West: 16%

Essentially, every team from the North and South division have "bad " luck while teams from the East and West division generally have "good" luck.

The reason is simple: schedule, which pits teams from the same division against each other more often than teams from other divisions.

The other component of schedule is a division rotation, where each division is matched up against another, with each playing every squad from said division. It just so happens that the two strongest divisions, North and South , are facing each other this year, while the East division has the privilege of beating up the unbelievably bad West division. Tougher schedules means tough losses for North and South teams.
