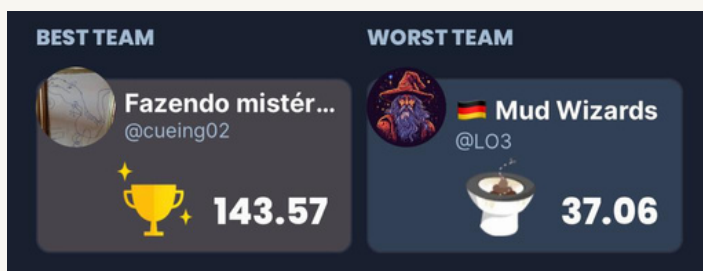

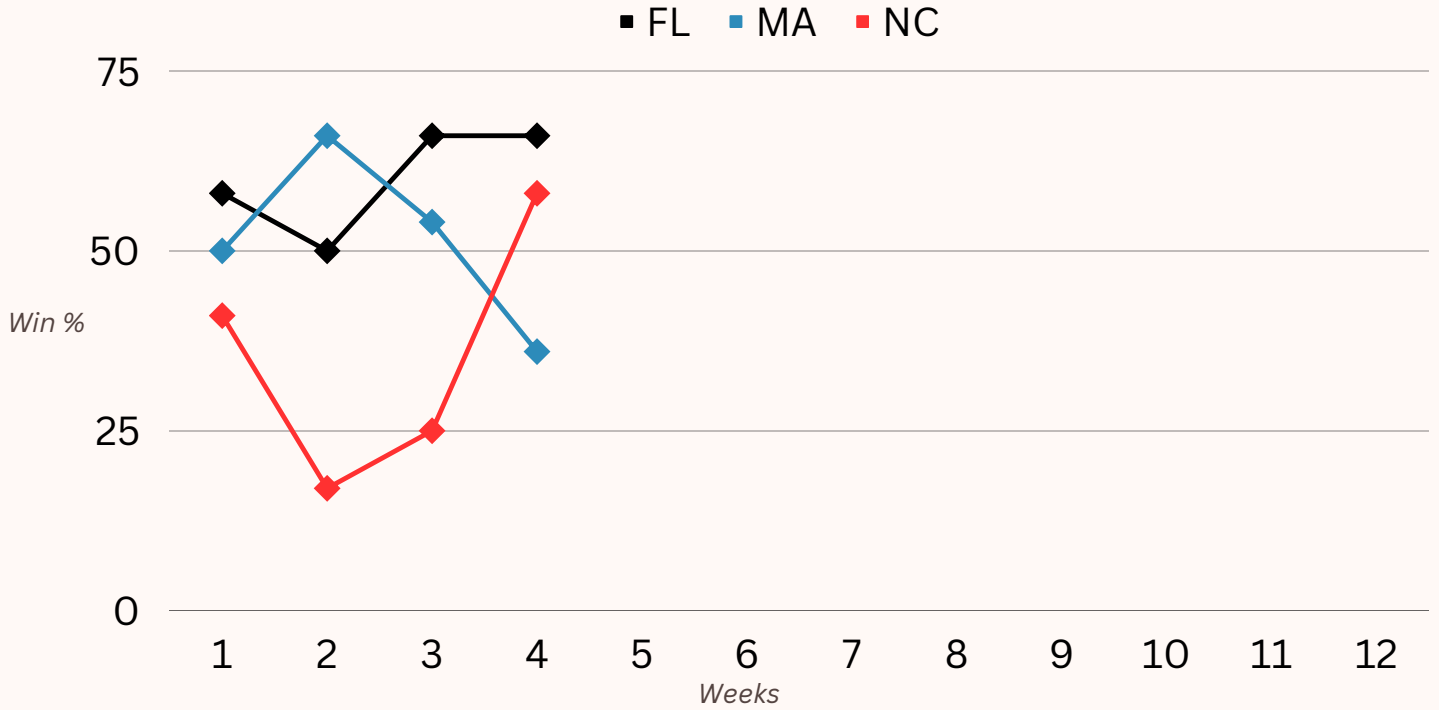

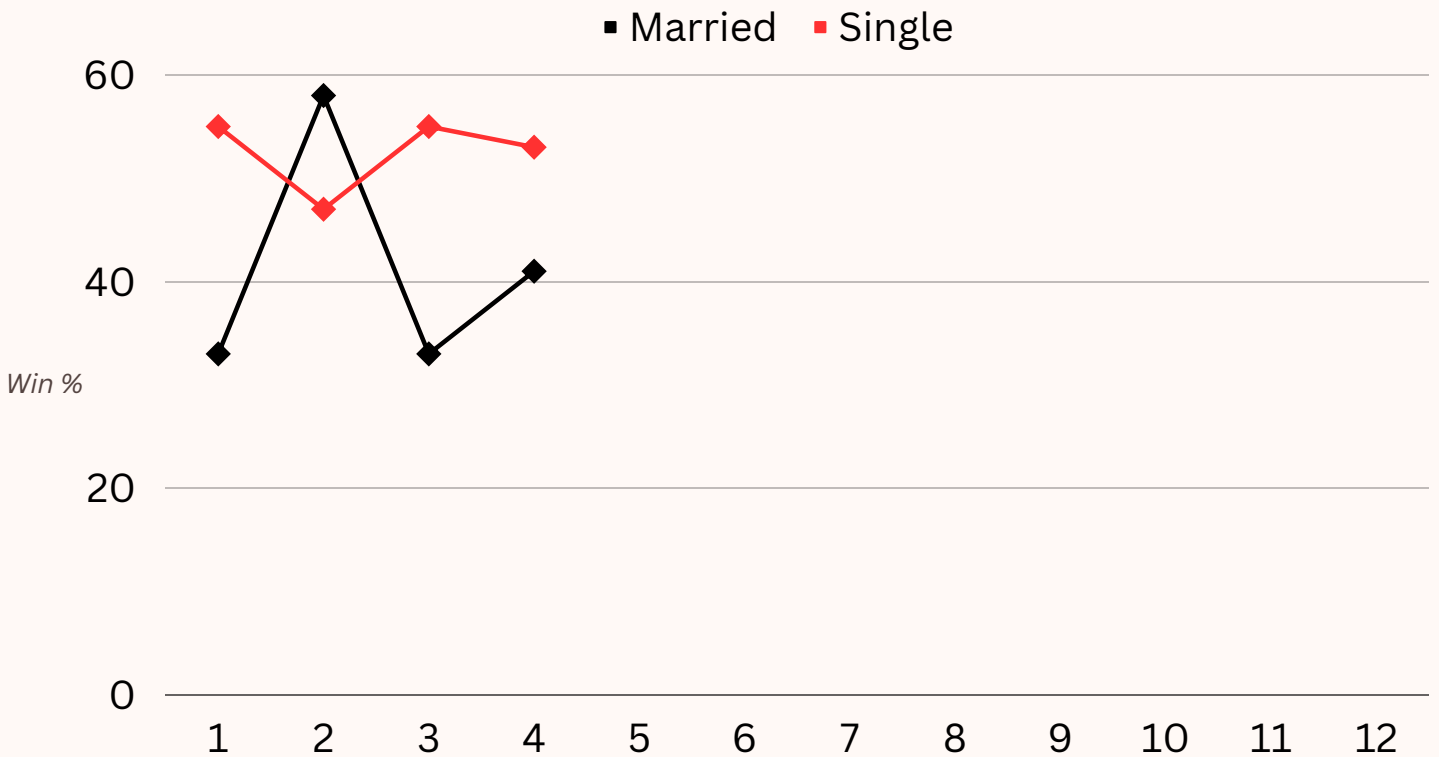

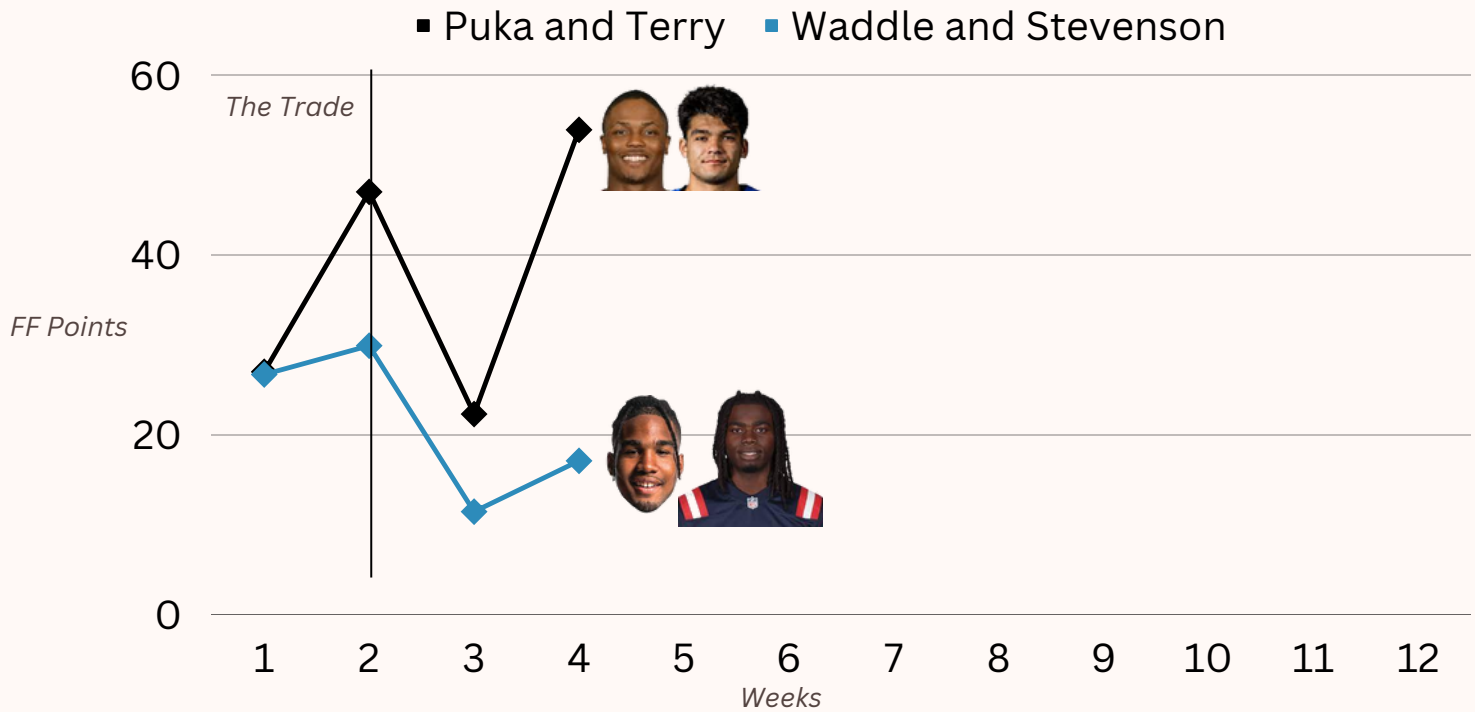
### Win Percentage per Region
