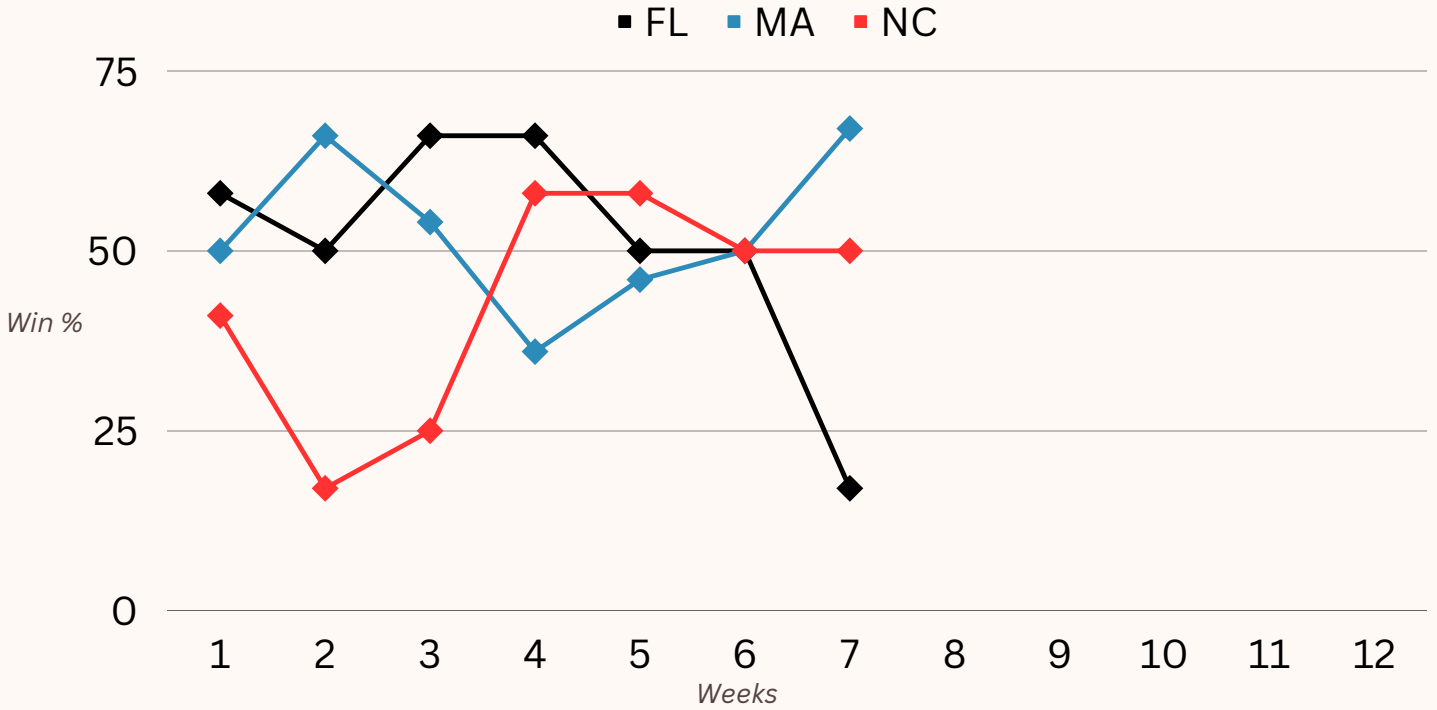

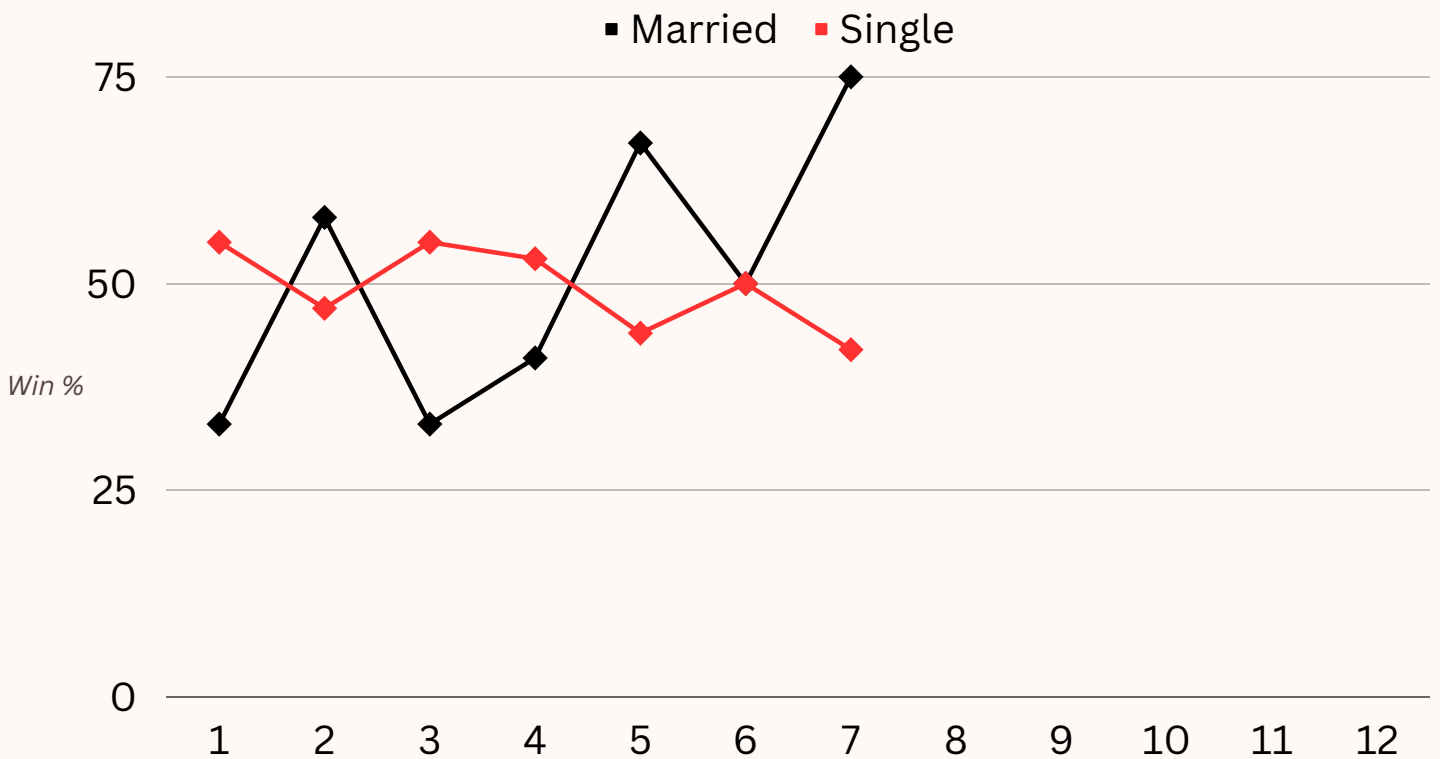

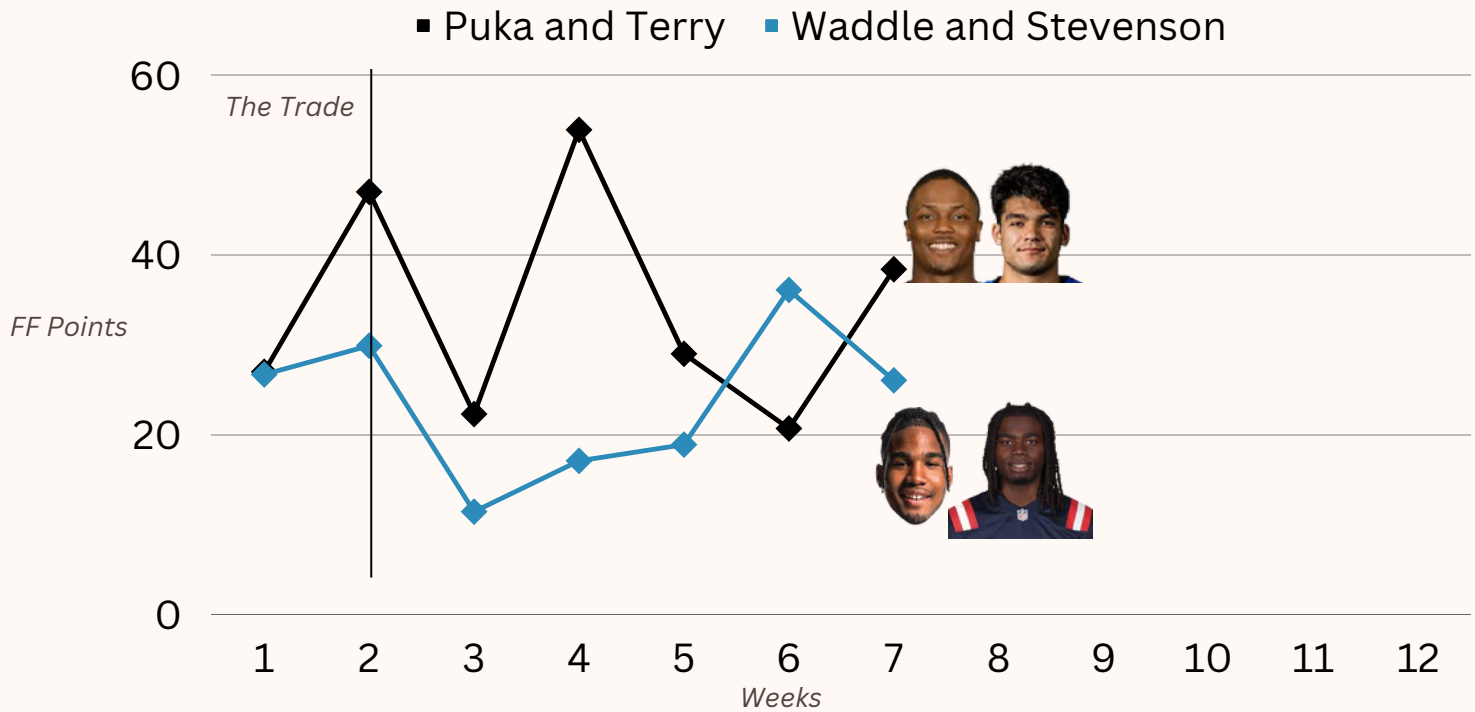
Win Percentage per Region
